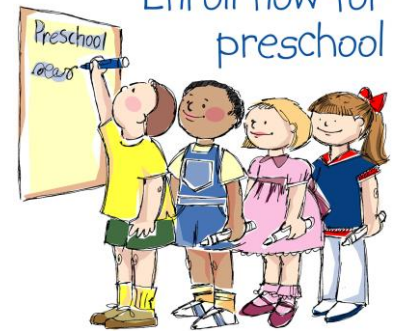

How the family fundraiser works

Family Fundraising Requirements:

Each family that is enrolled at PVCS is required to raise a family fundraising fee to help offset the cost of attending our school. This amount can be raised through fundraising or just paid in full by the family.

For Preschool Families the amount is \$250

For all other grades the amount is \$450

The fundraising monies contribute to 8-10% of our total operating budget.

The fundraising monies help keep tuition lower and affordable for all families.

How to raise the funds:

- **Golf-a-thon**: The annual PVCS Golf-a-thon is a miniature golf fun day at Old Town. Students obtain sponsors from local companies, family members and friends. Companies that sponsor the student are advertised at the school and Old Town, as well as social media. A portion of the monies raised by your individual student(s) will go toward your annual fundraising amount.
- **Bake Sales**: Participate in bake sales. A percentage of the amount that your baked goods sold for will be put toward your family fundraising amount.
- **Annual School Carnival**: In May, the annual school carnival is an opportunity to provide auction items for live and silent auctions. A portion of whatever your auction item sells for goes towards your family fundraising amount. In the past, anything from Rockies tickets, gift baskets, guns, health packages, gift cards and other items donated by local businesses have been auctioned.
- **Self-Fundraising**: In the past, families have had yard sales and have asked family members and/or local businesses to help contribute to their family fundraising amount.
- We are always open for more fundraising ideas. Please talk to Mr. Lewis to express more fundraising opportunities.
