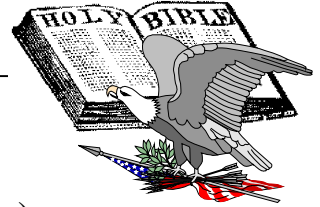




Elementary Discipline Policy

Kindergarten – 5th Grade



(Discipline Emphasizing 1st - Time Obedience)

This is the procedure used in the day-to-day running of a classroom. Students will receive demerits and will follow the overall procedure as the demerits accumulate by 25, 50, 75 & 100.

Green All students start the day with a green card.

Yellow Caution

- Loss of privilege

Red Stop

- Loss of privilege
- Demerit given according to offense

Black In Big Trouble

- More demerits given according to the offense
- Parents called
- **If student continues to misbehave after parents are called, then parents will be called again to come and get the child for the remaining portion of that day.**
- **If student chooses not to return the signed demerit slip the next morning, then student will accompany teacher to the office to call parents.**

Students involved in **P.E, library, playground, Character First, music, and/or Chapel** will receive demerits immediately for wrong behavior from that particular classroom teacher.

These special activities are considered a privilege, therefore, wrong behavior will not be tolerated.

Teachers are asked to fill out and have students sign demerits before leaving the area.

Principal may become involved at any time in the above discipline process pertaining to these activities.

Each behavior is rated differently. Please see attached sheet for rating differences.
