**Attentiveness:** Showing the worth of a person by giving full concentration to his or her words.

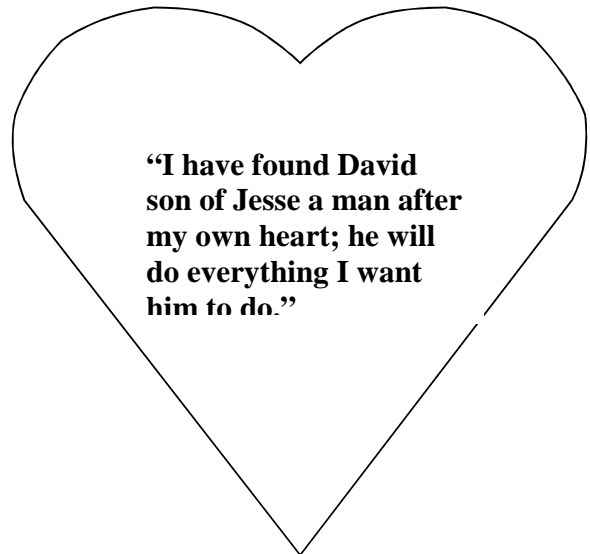
**I WILL:**
